## FACTS

- This project will not be possible without YOUR support!
- Gadsden is one of few cities in the United States that has not already implemented a recycling service.
- Recycling 125 aluminum cans saves enough energy to power an average home for one day.
- Recycling one ton of paper saves 17 trees and saves 7000 gallons of water.
- Energy saved from recycling one glass bottle equals 3 hours of electricity given off by a household light bulb.
- Energy saved from one ton of paper is equivalent to 4100 kilowatt hours or heat for 6 months.
- Sylacauga generates 150 tons of recyclables each month in a town of 13,000.
- Recycling will not only save Gadsden residents money, but will reduce the area landfill and preserve the environment!!!
